



Awards to recognise our community's inspiring volunteers

Now's the time to give back to the people who give our community so much.

Nominations for the Wagga Wagga Local Achievement Awards are open across five categories - Diversity and Inclusion, Education, Healthy and Active Living, Arts and Culture, and Intergenerational Leadership.

The Wagga Wagga Local Achievement Awards recognise and celebrate the volunteer work of women and men aged 50 and over.

"We are lucky to have so many people in our community that selflessly give their time to clubs, groups, causes and more," Mayor of the City of Wagga Wagga Councillor Greg Conkey OAM said.

"The Wagga Wagga Local Achievement Awards are a fantastic way to thank our volunteers for their enormous contribution to our community.

"If you or your community group know someone whose work deserves to be celebrated, please get your nominations in before 4 February."

The awards are co-presented by Wagga Wagga City Council and Member for Wagga Wagga Dr Joe McGirr.

Earlier this year, community stalwarts including Betty Miller (Intergenerational Leadership Award category 2), David Gilbey (Arts & Culture Awards), Don Tuckwell (Healthy & Active Living), Mahdi Rahimi (Intergenerational Leadership Award category 1) and Peggy Adamson (Diversity & Inclusion Award) were recognised in the 2018 awards.

"Every day I meet the amazing men and women, who make Wagga a diverse, active and inspiring place to live," Dr McGirr said.

"The Local Achievement Awards give us a chance to recognise and pay tribute to them and the work they do across our communities.

"So I ask you to take a look around at the people you know, who really go out of their way to help others and take responsibility for making Wagga better. If you know someone like that, I encourage you to take a few minutes to nominate them."

Nominations are open to any Wagga Wagga Local Government Area resident aged 50 years and over, while the Intergenerational Leadership category is open to people aged between 12 to 25 years and 50 years and over.
